



## Elementary ESL Schedule of Equitable Services for Students

The following information is provided by the ESL program to ensure equity of services for all students designated as Limited English Proficient (LEP) by state definition.

~Minutes are a minimum amount of services designated to the students.

~ Please note that Level 1-2 students in third through fifth grade are the highest priority.

\* Denotes grades with Newcomer center for Intensive L1s. These students receive 1400 minutes of ESL instruction per week.

\*\*If a student has a disability, the ESL teacher should consult with the Special ed. teacher as to the most appropriate amount of ESL services. Some students may require a 30 min. monthly consult based on their learning needs.
